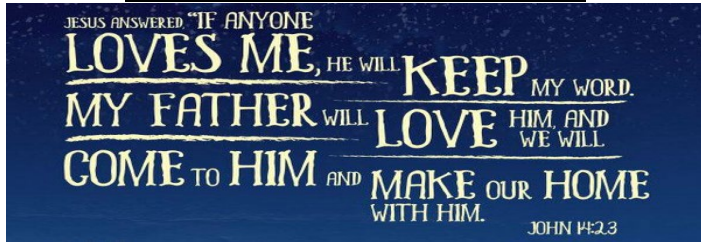

## **KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS UKRAINE FUNDRAISING & SUPPORT UPDATE**

Thank you for the generous support and donations to the Knights of Columbus, Halton Columbus Charities Ukraine Fund. Donations to the Knights of Columbus for Ukraine total \$ 9,617.49 as of May 5<sup>th</sup>. Knights of Columbus worldwide have raised \$ 14,897,551.00 which is given to Knights in Poland who purchase medicine, food, and essentials in Poland and deliver them to Knights in Western Ukraine who in turn hand out to those in need. The Ukraine funds raised by the Knights of Columbus; Halton Columbus Charities will be added to the worldwide total. In addition, the Knights in Poland have set up an orphanage which has taken in over 1,000 Ukraine orphans. Halton Columbus Charities is registered with CRA and operated by the members of Knights of Columbus Council # 5073.
