

ASH WEDNESDAY February 22



Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent and is always 46 days before Easter Sunday. Lent is a 40-day season (not counting Sundays) marked by repentance, fasting, reflection, and ultimately celebration. The 40day period represents Christ's time of

temptation in the wilderness, where he fasted and where Satan tempted him. Lent asks believers to set aside a time each year for similar fasting, marking an intentional season of focus on Christ's life, ministry, sacrifice, and resurrection.

DISCIPLINES OF LENT

As Lent begins, we are invited "to struggle against everything that leads us away from the love of God and neighbour" by exercising the **DISCIPLINE OF LENT: Repentance, Fasting, Prayer and Works of Love.** These become the specific occasions and opportunities for spiritual renewal during this season of renewal. Living out a discipline takes our Lord's words about self-denial seriously (Matt.16:24). Through discipline, we find freedom and grace, just as parental discipline is loving and brings a child to freedom and righteousness (Heb.12:3-13).

- THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS Every Tuesday at 7:30 p.m. following the 7:00 p.m.
- **BENEDICTION** Every Friday morning after the 8:30 a.m. Mass
