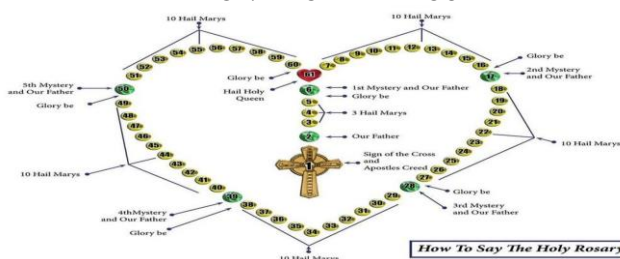
### VOCATION VIEW
