AROUND THE DIOCESE



Desiring to support the work of the Holy Spirit in the Diocese of Hamilton, Forward Together in Christ was initiated to help the bishop to better discern how to move the Diocese forward after the struggles and limitations imposed by Covid 19. Close to 1000 people across the diocese participated in these opportunities to speak together and offer the bishop wisdom and experience.

The main overall concern that arose was communication: **Communication between the Chancery and**

parishes, bishops and priests, priests and deacons, clergy and laity, pastors and principals, and parishioners within their local parish settings. There seemed to be a growing sense of "us and them". The idea of being together, on the same side, seemed to be far from the perceived reality.

This struggle of communication showed itself in all areas of discussion. There is a need for greater clarity on relationships and roles among the various members of the Church.
